June 2013 Competition Report

New Track at Pocono-Northern New Jersey Region held the Joe DeLuca and Linda Gronlund Freedom Races were held at Pocono Raceway May 11, 12, 2013. The results are not online yet, but the entries were down around 80 cars. Pete Smith, Demetrius Mossaidis and I were the only MoHud drivers I saw there. Pete and I found a nice paddock spot near the Grid and next to Smarty and his Hoosier truck.

The new Track is great; it is the same configuration that we ran about 10 years ago. Clockwise you pass Start/Finish and turn right into the infield, sweeping right hander, hard left turn, right hander, left hander and a right at Devils Elbow on to the NASCAR Oval, tunnel turn and straight to where the chicane used to be, then a right turn into the infield trough some esses and over a blind hill, hard left turn and then a right onto NASCAR straight back to Start/Finish. The big change is that all the infield turns have FIA curbing and plenty of runoff. The format was two sanction numbers and 3 Races, Pete and I were 2 thirds of the F Production field, the other F Prod car was Bob Spreen in his Spridget. Qualifying was in the rain I got the F prod pole but Pete only did two laps. The Saturday race was in the rain and Pete flew by me on the start I managed to keep up with him in the rain and we lapped Bob who was spitting and skipping as we passed him. After the race we discovered he only had 20 % compression in number 4 cylinder. Pete had the fastest lap and since it was a new track he set the F Production Lap Record. Sunday's races were in the dry, Pete won again and set another lap record, I finished 2nd out of two. When we tried to leave impound, Pete's car would not start, we could hear the starter but that was all. Investigation revealed that his ring gear had separated from the fly wheel. Since I was the last man standing, I breezed to victory in the 2nd Sunday race. I do not know how Demetrius finished but I know he qualified well.

SCCA Majors Showing Significant Increases In Participation

TOPEKA, Kan. (May 16, 2013) – When Sports Car Club of America launched the U.S. Majors Tour last September, one of the primary goals was to cluster competition amongst the best racers in the SafeRacer National Series. Through the first eight Majors races of 2013, that target has been reached, with car counts up nearly 19 percent from 2012.

Comparing the 2013 Majors Tour races to the equivalent National Races a season ago, four of the early season races – Auto Club Speedway, Road Atlanta, VIRginia International Raceway, and Summit Point –individually



increased more than 20 percent. The early May race at Summit Point led the way with an increase of 28.24 percent average attendance per day, well above the 18.96% jump across the board.

Those numbers ignore the March debut at Circuit of the Americas, which hosted a season-high 936 entries during both days of the doubleheader.

"This is a transition year for the U.S. Majors Tour and the entire Club Racing program, but we have been very pleased with the increased car counts thus far," SCCA President & CEO Jeff Dahnert said. "All of the events thus far have seen an increase from 2012, with all but one increasing more than 16 percent.

"With any new program, there will be some trepidation, and we appreciate the trust instilled in us by our Regions and their partnership in these events. As we work through the remainder of this season and look to 2014, we are excited to focus on enhancing the experience for our participants and growing the Conference Championships to new levels."

The data includes the opening eight events on the 19-event schedule. Each of the remaining events, with the exception of the WeatherTech June Sprints at Road America, are doubleheaders. The June Sprints offers a bonus race for half of the run groups on the weekend.

The U.S. Majors Tour is divided into four geographic conferences to give SCCA Club Racers a championship experience without cross-country travel. Each of the four Conferences – Eastern, Northern, Mid-States and Western – will crown a champion in all 28 Runoffs-eligible classes. The U.S. Majors Tour is the top level of SCCA's strong amateur racing program.
