# COMPETITION REPORT Jack Hanifan

#### **March 2014 Competition Report**

**NARRC Banquet**- MoHud hosted the NARRC Banquet in Marlborough, MA, on February 8<sup>th</sup>. There were 20 NARRC Champions recognized. Each Champion received a Clock Trophy, Jacket, Hat and Equipment bag. Demetrius (Mickey) Mossaidis was the only MoHud recipient. Mickey was the ITA Champion.

**Drivers Schools**- The schedule for Schools in the NE is light. The schools scheduled are: March 22, 23 at New Jersey Motorsports Park, March 29, and 30 at Summit Point, April 26 at Pittsburgh International Raceway, May 23 at New Hampshire Motor Speedway and October 3<sup>rd</sup> at Watkins Glen International.

Alternative Schools- If you have had some type of previous wheel to wheel racing experience, MoHud can always arrange and Alternative School. Depending upon your experience this could either be held at LRP on a test day or possibly at NHMS or Thompson. If you have any questions contact me.

**NeDiv Divisional Series**- Since we no longer have National Races, the NeDiv Champions will be determined by an eight race Divisional Series. Champions will be crowned in all eligible classes. Drivers in Runoff eligible classes can qualify for the SCCA National Runoffs at Laguna Seca. These races are all Regional races and a Full Competition License, National License or Regional license is eligible to compete. The Races are schedule for April 4,5 at Summit Point, May 24,25 at New Hampshire, June 14,25 at Pittsburgh, June 28,29 at New Jersey, July 26,27 at Nelson, August 9,10 at Pocono, September 13,14 at Watkins Glen and September 26,27 at Lime Rock.

**Tech Party**- Since the first NYSRRC/ NARRC race is May 10, 11 at Pocono, we are tentatively scheduling the Tech Party for Saturday May 3<sup>rd</sup>, later than usual but warmer for the hot dogs. More information next month.

Preferred numbers- I have received several calls about reserved numbers, since there are no National Races, there are not any Reserved National Numbers. If you are running the Major Series, you can buy a reserved Majors Number, go to the Majors website. Regional Races-Each Regional Race Series can have their preferred numbers. Marsha Toombs from Finger Lakes is handling NYSRRC Preferred Numbers. Check the NARRC website for their numbers. Please note that other than the Majors where you buy your number the numbers are not reserved but rather preferred numbers. If you do not enter an event by a certain date you might not get your number or if race groups merge, the same may apply.

# SCCA Announces Solo Driver and Rookie of the Year Winners

**TOPEKA, Kan. (Feb. 13, 2014)** – The Sports Car Club of America revealed the winners of two of the most prestigious awards up for grabs each year at the Tire Rack Solo National Championships, announcing the Solo Driver of the Year and Rookie of the Year in advance of the official presentations at the SCCA National Convention, March 7-9 in Charlotte, N.C.

Tom O'Gorman, of Mason, Ohio, was named the SCCA Solo Driver of the Year, while Darren Seltzer, of Orlando, Fla., capped off an amazing season with a National Championship, earning Rookie of the Year honors.

The Solo Driver of the Year award is given to the driver who produced an outstanding performance at the Solo National Championships, while demonstrating exceptional skill or overcoming a major obstacle in the process. The winning driver is selected by the Solo Events Board from nominations sent in by the general membership.

The Rookie of the Year recognizes a top-level performance at the Solo National Championships by a driver with limited competition experience.

Both awards are scheduled to be presented to the winners at the SCCA Hall of Fame Induction and Awards Banquet Presented by Mazda, March 8, as part of the SCCA National Convention.

While winning the F Prepared National Championship by a three-second margin is impressive in its own right, the fact that O'Gorman did it at 21 years old is equally as notable. Already a Solo veteran with seven years of experience under his belt, there is little doubt that this award will be one of many which he will rack up during his driving career.

Even before getting to Lincoln (Neb.) for the Solo National Championship, O'Gorman recorded some impressive stats. In his 14 meets during 2013, O'Gorman was the top driver in his class in 13 of those. When compared to the rest of the field, across all classes, he tallied the quickest indexed times in seven events and was in the top five for 12 events.

Aside from his supreme talent behind the wheel, O'Gorman is recognized as a respectful, humble and sportsmanlike competitor.

Seltzer made the most of his Tire Rack Solo National Championship debut, taking home the F Modified title by a three-second margin. While Seltzer's background in kart racing afforded him some experience in high performance driving, competing in Lincoln presented some different challenges.

From the start, Seltzer and his car owner, Greg Shumaker, were struggling to find replacement parts and had begun looking for a different car in which to compete.

While they were able to get to Lincoln with an intact competition vehicle, once again, they ran into problems. During the test day the exhaust broke on the Raptor they were driving, forcing a repair. In the midst of the two-day competition, a large frame crack developed, but did not get in the way of Seltzer taking home top honors.

The Solo awards are just two of the awards officially presented at the SCCA Hall of Fame Induction and Awards Banquet Presented by Mazda during the SCCA National Convention and MSX Expo, March 7-9. The ceremony is highlighted by the 2014 SCCA Hall of Fame class inductions, featuring Kathy Barnes, Bob Bondurant, Dan Gurney, Dr. Bob Hubbard and Jim Downing, and Pete Hylton.
