

COMPETITION REPORT Jack Hanifan

May 2014 Competition Report

NARRC Banquet - MoHud hosted the NARRC Banquet in Marlborough, MA on February 8th. There were 20 NARRC Champions recognized. Each Champion received a Clock Trophy, Jacket, Hat and Equipment bag. Demetrius (Mickey) Mossaidis was the only MoHud recipient. Mickey was the ITA Champion.

Drivers Schools - The schedule for Schools in the NE is light. The schools scheduled are: March 22, 23 at New Jersey Motorsports Park, March 29, and 30 at Summit Point, April 26 at Pittsburgh International Raceway, May 23 at New Hampshire Motor Speedway and October 3rd at Watkins Glen International.

Alternative Schools - If you have had some type of previous wheel to wheel racing experience, MoHud can always arrange an Alternative School. Depending on your experience this could either be held at LRP on a test day or possibly at NHMS or Thompson. If you have any questions contact me.

NeDiv Divisional Series - Since we no longer have National Races, the NeDiv Champions will be determined by an eight race Divisional Series. Champions will be crowned in all eligible classes. Drivers in Runoff eligible classes can qualify for the SCCA National Runoffs at Laguna Seca. These races are all Regional races and a Full Competition License, National License or Regional license is eligible to compete. The Races are schedule for April 4, 5 at Summit Point, May 24, 25 at New Hampshire, June 14, 15 at Pittsburgh, June 28, 29 at New Jersey, July 26, 27 at Nelson, August 9, 10 at Pocono, September 13, 14 at Watkins Glen and September 26, 27 at Lime Rock.

Tech Party - Since the first NYSRRC/ NARRC race is May 10-11 at Pocono, we are tentatively scheduling the Tech Party for Saturday May 3rd.- later than usual but warmer for the hot dogs. More information next month.

Preferred numbers - I have received several calls about reserved numbers. Since there are no National Races, there are not any Reserved National Numbers. If you are running the Major Series, you can buy a reserved Majors Number; go to the Majors website to do so. Regional Races - each Regional Race Series can have their preferred numbers. Marsha Toombs from Finger Lakes Region is handling NYSRRC Preferred Numbers. Check the NARRC website for their numbers. **Please note:** Other than the Majors where you buy your number, numbers are not reserved but rather are preferred numbers. If you do not enter an event by a certain date you may not get your number OR if race groups merge, the same may apply.



Female Drivers Rothmuller, Tooth Named Inaugural Recipients of SCCA Wendi Allen Scholarship

TOPEKA, Kan. (April 3, 2014) – The Sports Car Club of America members tout themselves as a "racing family," eager to lend a hand where needed and assist others whenever possible. The latest example of that comes in the Solo community, where Lori Rothmuller and Sarah Tooth were recently named the first recipients of the Wendi Allen Scholarship.

The Wendi Allen Scholarship Fund provides support to promising young women Solo competitors, offering free entries to Tire Rack SCCA Solo National Tour events, a set of tires for The Tire Rack Solo National Championships from BFGoodrich Tires, and

\$1500 in cash to be used for event expenses throughout the year.

The scholarship was conceived and funded by the family of Wendi Allen, an eight-time National Champion who competed with her husband, Mark. Allen was a fixture at the National Championships from 1994 until 2005, when sidelined while pregnant with twin daughters Cassidy and Caitlin (now competing in the Formula Junior class). Allen competed every year at the Solo National Championships through 2012 before concentrating her strength on her current, long-time battle with cancer.

Rothmuller and Tooth were selected by a committee of successful female drivers, chaired by Tara Johns and including Beth McClure-Strelnieks, Denise Cashmore, Shelly Monfort, and Patty Tunnell. Responsible for selecting two scholarship winners each season, the group has claimed 31 National Championships, in total, and is recognized as leaders on and off the course. The support for these recipients is not limited to financial backing, however as the program seeks to offer driver training, mentoring and event logistic assistance as well. For the Allen family, it is a way to ensure that the legacy Allen most wishes to leave in the sport is maintained.

Rothmuller, 21, is a University of California, Davis student who heads the Davis Motorsports Club focusing on student participation in amateur motorsports, especially SCCA Solo. Not only a participant, Rothmuller draws other college students to the sport with her efforts. In her only previous visit to The Tire Rack Solo National

Championships in 2011, Rothmuller finished fifth in B Street Prepared Ladies.

"Winning this award is almost surreal, and a huge honor," Rothmuller said. "I wasn't familiar with Wendi Allen's story before I was nominated, but I am now, as well as knowing some of Shelley Monfort's story. Both women are incredibly inspiring. They are the top tier of female autocrossers, and to be picked for this award by them, to possibly someday emulate them is such an honor. Winning this scholarship means that I could, potentially, carry on this legacy, which is really exciting."

Tooth migrated from Alberta, Canada to Houston, Texas two years ago to attend Rice University as a grad student, getting involved in the Houston Region events and regularly recruiting new SCCA members to events. A quick study, Tooth finished second in the Street Touring FWD Ladies class in her 2013 debut at the Tire Rack Solo National Championships. The scholarship package will be a sure boost to her early success.

"This scholarship is an incredible opportunity to learn and grow as a driver," Tooth said. "I'd like to win more often than I do, because that's fun. But I'd also like to gain a better understanding of how my car works, and how to set it up for particular effects. When I started I couldn't even change a wheel if I got a flat, so I've come a long way already."

Pleased with the initial selection, the responsibilities for the committee are just beginning.

"This is an amazing opportunity to get more women involved in this great sport," Johns said. "As women, we tend to be more cautious entering into an intense sport, especially one that is dominated by men. I am hopeful that through this Fund, we will be able to mentor women who will develop into amazing competitors and assets to our community. I remember how intimidating it was to go to my first national-level event. I also believe that we can help these promising women ease into the sport and continue to grow competitive ladies classes."

50th SCCA National Championship Runoffs Races Available on DVD, Digital Download

TOPEKA, Kan. (April 15, 2014) – All 24 races broadcast from the 50th SCCA® National Championship Runoffs® are now available individually on DVD or via digital download through Amazon.com and CreateSpace, an Amazon company.



The 24 races, covering 28 SCCA National Championship classes, can be purchased for \$8.99 per race on DVD, and \$2.99 per race as a download. The digital download can be streamed on an Amazon video –compatible device, or downloaded to be viewed anywhere without an internet connection.

"The demand for full DVD sets has waned each year since introducing the webcast, and we've received numerous requests for video downloads beyond watching the on-demand broadcasts, which requires an internet connection," Eric Prill, SCCA VP of Marketing/Communications, said. "In evaluating available options, Amazon's platform provided both an opportunity for downloads, but also DVDs of individual races on demand."

The races are available for purchase immediately.

"We planned to have these available late in 2013, but encountered a number of unexpected delays with the new process," Prill said. "While later than we had planned, we are excited to offer these new methods to relive and archive the excitement of the Runoffs."

Storylines/Things To Watch For

Major League: In September 2012, the Sports Car Club of America rolled out the U.S. Majors Tour as the top level of amateur racing in this country. The Majors Tour replaces what was previously called "National" SCCA racing, split into a season-long championship in four geographic Conferences. This weekend's event for the Eastern Conference at VIR has pulled approximately 250 top-level drivers from the east coast and beyond.

SCCA Club Racers – The Best In The Country: There are lots of amateur road racing groups in the United States, but the clear leader of top drivers is with the SCCA. Though most are weekend warriors who take vacations from their full-time jobs to attend races, it's a craft taken seriously. Bobby Rahal, Mark Donohue, Roger Penske, Michael Andretti, and actor/driver Paul Newman got their start in SCCA Club Racing. More recently, you could have seen current stars Boris Said, Graham Rahal, Sam Hornish or J.R. Hildebrand at an SCCA Club race.

Easter Weekend Celebration: With 250 cars on the entry list this weekend, the competition is stout in the 27 Runoffs-eligible classes in attendance. Eight run groups, as was run at Road Atlanta for the BFGoodrich Tires Super Tour, spreads that competition throughout the day.

Friday's schedule is full of qualifying; Saturday and Sunday feature eight race groups each day. Saturday's grids are set by quickest laps in qualifying, while Sunday's races also consider fast race lap from Saturday in the best times.

GT-2 Heavy Hitters: A fast and furious 11 GT-2 cars are on the entry list, and while that may not be the biggest class of the weekend, few can match its star power. The class represents 15 SCCA National Championships, including defending Champion Andrew Aquilante, who holds three titles. Jim Goughary (4), Tom Patton (1) and Pete Peterson (7) are also involved in this weekend's showdown.

Eight Run Groups Set for Day One of Competition at VIR

ALTON, Va. (April 18, 2014) – Hazy clouds and a consistent breeze greeted a full paddock of 245 competitors on Friday morning as they qualified for the first half of the doubleheader SCCA US Majors Tour Eastern Conference weekend at VIRginia International Raceway. However, the unseasonably cool temperatures did not deter the drivers when it came to pushing the limits on the newly-paved and widened racing surface at the historic circuit.

In fact, the characteristics of the course

have changed so much that the record book has been wiped clean. The fast times set during today's pair of 20-minute qualifying sessions and the fast laps through the remainder of the weekend's schedule, will set the new standard for all SCCA classes at the 17-turn, 3.27-mile track.

Spec Racer Ford, featuring 52 entries, and Spec Miata, with 28 cars, are the largest single-class groups racing this weekend. But, there are several other classes that have attracted some respectable numbers and top talent. The GT-2 field is made up of 11 drivers that have a combined 15 National Championships to their names, including defending National Champion Andrew Aquilante. Jim Goughary, Tom Patton and Pete Peterson are the remaining Runoffs gold medal winners who will take to the new pavement in their GT-2 machines.

Formula Enterprise is another well-subscribed class, boasting 11 entries. Like the GT-2 class, the talent pool in this class goes deep. Defending National Champion and Super Sweep winner Scott Rettich headlines a field that includes Brandon Kennedy, who has already scored a pair of Eastern Conference wins at Sebring and PBIR. Paul Schneider will also be a threat for the win as he looks to add to his six consecutive Eastern Conference podium finishes, thus far in 2014.

Each of the eight race groups were allowed two 20-minute qualifying sessions on Friday, the best time of which will be used to set Saturday's starting grid. For Sunday's grid the best lap time from the two qualifying sessions or Saturday's race will be used to determine each driver's position.

Each SCCA U.S. Majors Tour event, part of the SafeRacer National Club Racing program, are run in a doubleheader format. Saturday's race will be a 20-minute timed race. Sunday's race will last 16 laps or 40 minutes, whichever comes first, followed by victory laps.
