SCCA TrackNight at Thompson Speedway MotorSports Park was all the fun you could pack into a few hours on a Wednesday. The objective was to get car enthusiasts out to experience a real race track, but without the element of competition. It's not a totally new concept, there have been other groups running track day events for quite some time, but this one was aimed at people with little or no previous exposure. The time commitment of an afternoon/evening, and a modest price point (\$150) hit its target at Thompson as nearly 60 signed up for the novice group (with another 25 or so in the intermediate/advanced category). An informal poll show of hands suggested that about half the novice group had no previous involvement aside from video games or watching races on TV. (The Novices were split into two groups to ensure that everyone had quality time and personal space).

SCCA hit the right balance of impressing the seriousness of the track environment and being customer-friendly to people encountering its many nuances for the first time. Proof of that at TMSP was that just one car had a minor off-course excursion, otherwise the laps flowed smoothly for the entire event. Aimed primarily at street cars there was a good deal of variety from a few econo-box sedans to a wide range of tuner cars, rice rockets, a Cobra kit car, up through the latest Porsches and Corvettes, but even our well-worn SSM Miata was not out of place.

Not to be underplayed is the restorative property that a few laps around a road course can bring to the soul. If you're an autocrosser you'll get more driving time in one TrackNight than in a season of dodging pylons. If you're usual role at the race track is on a flag station or other official duties you'll surely appreciate a different vantage point. If you're just someone who likes cars and driving, it's a rare opportunity to engage in spirited motoring, and vastly safer than any conditions you'll encounter on public roads.

Even without the measure of competition, against other cars or the clock, it's rejuvenating, with the freedom to enjoy the race track and expand your skills at your own pace. It's kind of like why skiers enjoy a day on the slopes. The TrackNight format provides three 20 minute track sessions, which was enough to time to discover the rhythm and flow. And instill an appetite for more \odot .

The efficient schedule alternated track sessions with group de-briefings and a little time to enjoy walking around looking at cars and meeting fellow enthusiasts. Before 8 p.m. everyone was on their way home.

I've been around this sport since the late 1960s (I ran my first autocross, when they were still called gymkhanas, in 1967, in a four-door ,6 cylinder, automatic transmission Chevelle) and TrackNight at Thompson was still able to put a smile on my face. Maybe it will do the same for you?

Thompson (which is about two and half hours from Albany) has three more TrackNights: Tuesday June 30, Thursday July 9 & Thursday August 6. A bit further afield TrackNight visits New Jersey MotorSports Park on June 10, July 8 and August 12.
